The 2025 Asian Contents & Film Market (ACFM) has successfully concluded its four-day journey, further solidifying its position as Asia's leading global content business platform.

This year's event achieved a record-breaking total attendance of 30,006 visitors, marking a 13.5% increase from the previous year. This growth continues the remarkable 36.7% surge recorded in 2024, demonstrating ACFM's sustained expansion trajectory. Market participation also reached new heights with 3,024 registered participants from 1,222 companies across 55 countries, representing a 14.37% growth compared to the previous year.

Celebrating its 20th edition, ACFM introduced three innovative programs to provide new direction and practical business value in the rapidly evolving content industry landscape. These include InnoAsia, exploring the convergence of innovative technology and content; The A, aggregating data on the Asian film industry and building a foundation for collaboration; and DOCSQUARE, establishing itself as an international hub for the documentary ecosystem. These programs showcase ACFM's evolution beyond a simple market into a central platform for industry information, insights, and networking, while offering perspectives on the industry's future.

Our core programs—Sales Market, Producer Hub, Busan Story Market, Asia Project Market, and Platform Busan—also demonstrated robust growth. We achieved substantial industry results across all areas, including Sales Market with 289 companies from 31 countries exhibiting booths, Producer Hub with 154 producers from 25 countries, The A publishing industry reports covering 17 Asian countries, and Asia Project Market facilitating a total of 726 business meetings.

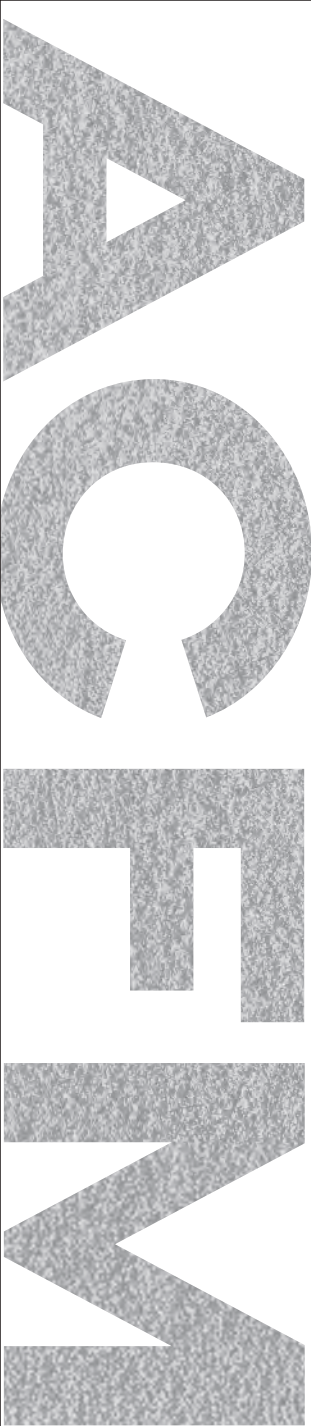

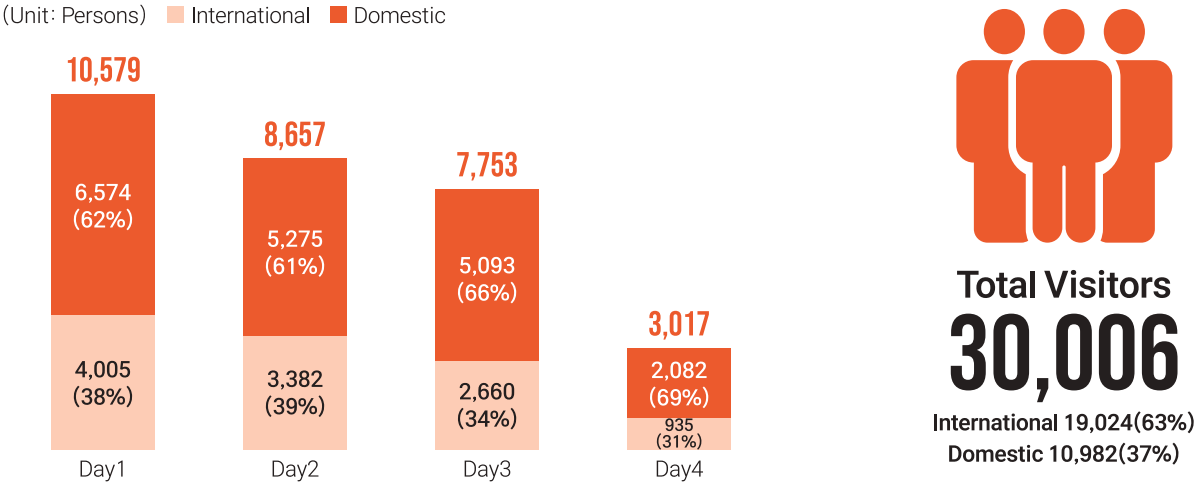
Asian Contents & Film Market 2025

Celebrating its 20th edition in 2025, the Asian Contents & Film Market (ACFM) successfully concluded its four-day event, further solidifying its position as Asia’s leading global business platform. This year’s event attracted a record-breaking total of 30,006 visitors, marking a 13.5% increase from the previous year and demonstrating ACFM’s continued growth. Participation also expanded significantly, with 3,024 professionals from 1,222 companies across 55 countries, representing a 14.37% rise compared to last year.

Expanding beyond film to include the AI technology sector within the broader content industry, this year’s ACFM fostered meaningful exchanges and collaborations among multinational participants. It once again reaffirmed its role as the central hub of the global content network, centered in Asia, with vast potential for the future.

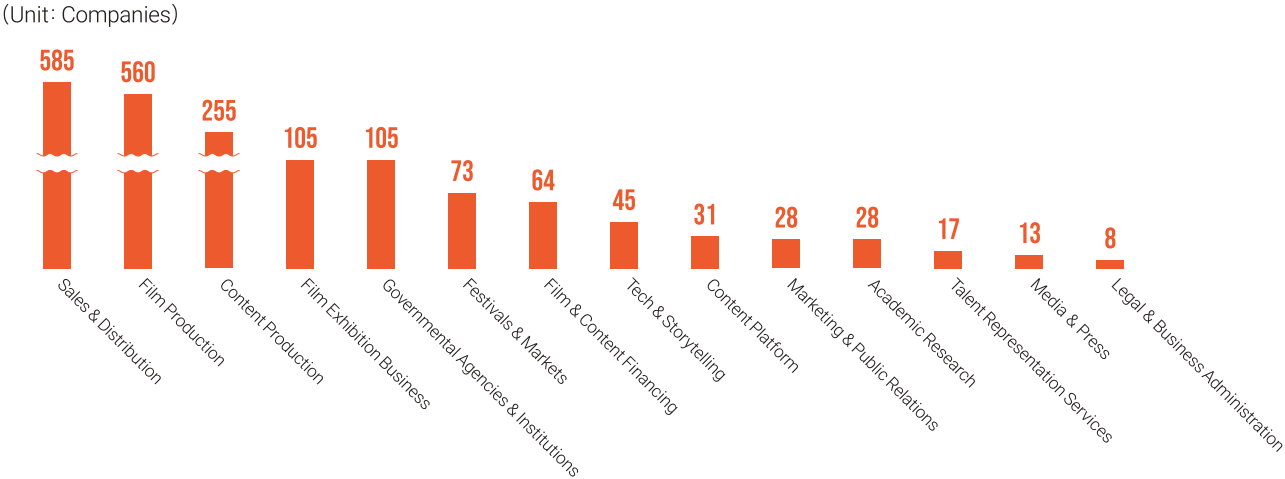

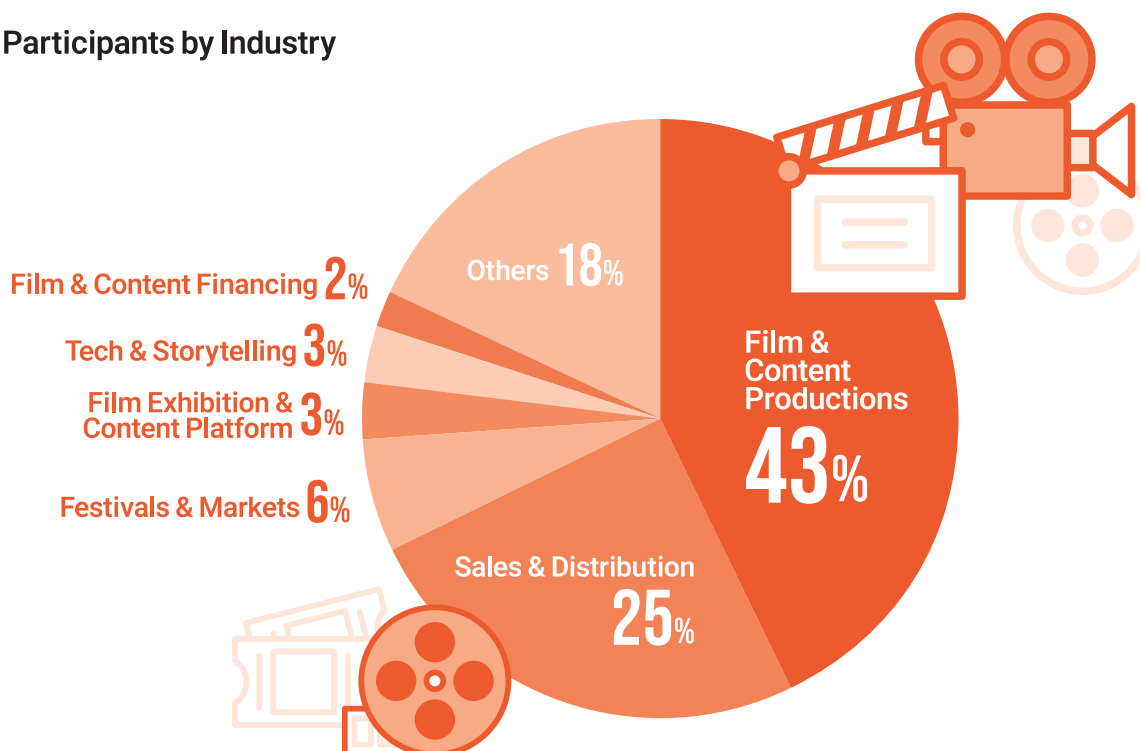

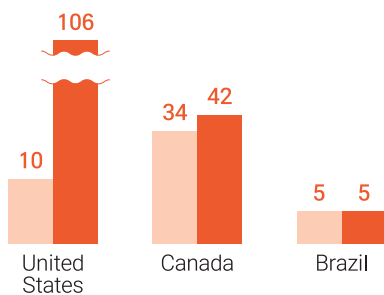
Participants by Industry

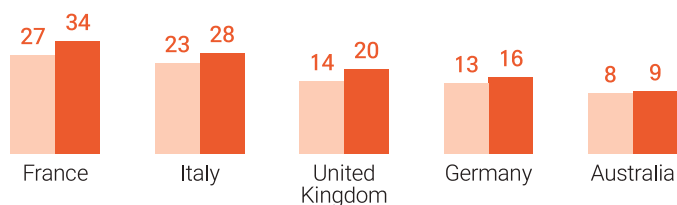

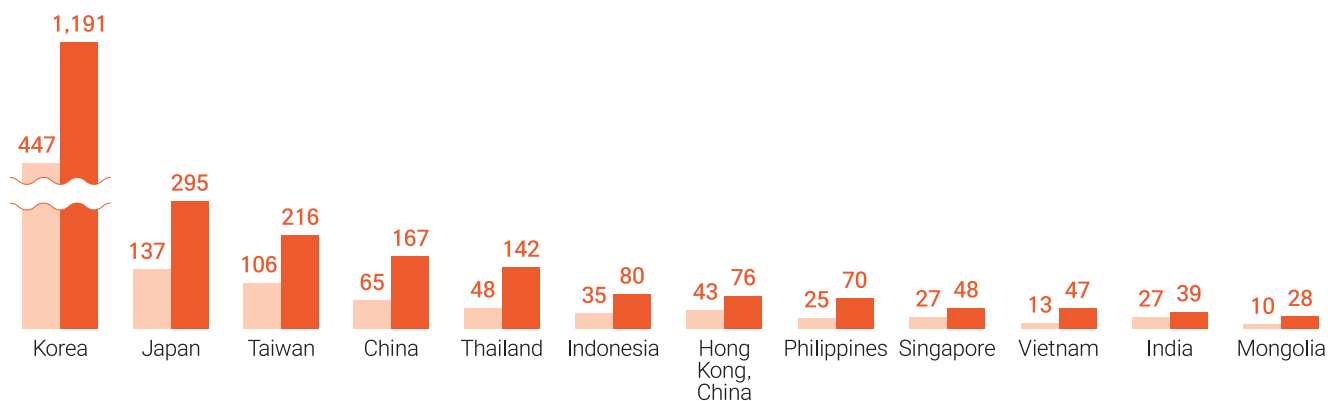

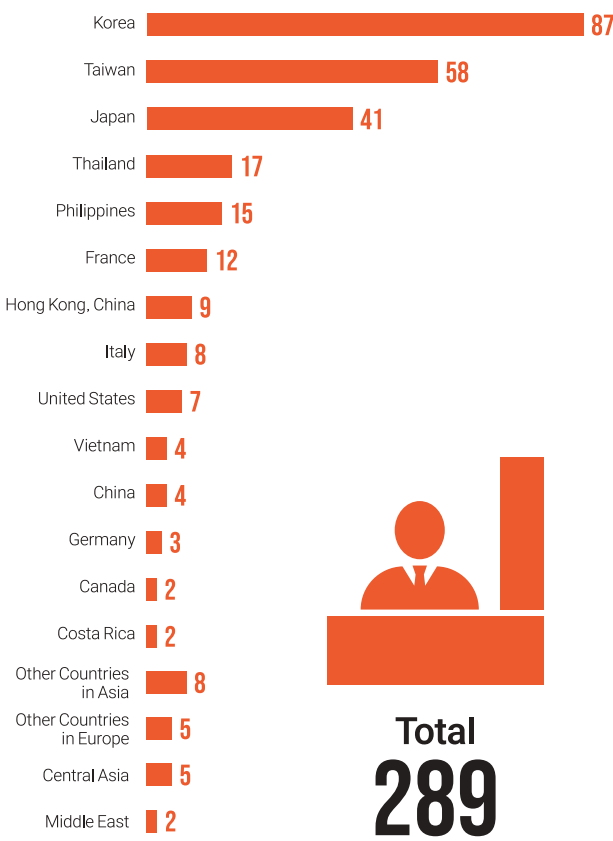
Number of Buyers by Region

Number of Exhibitors by Region

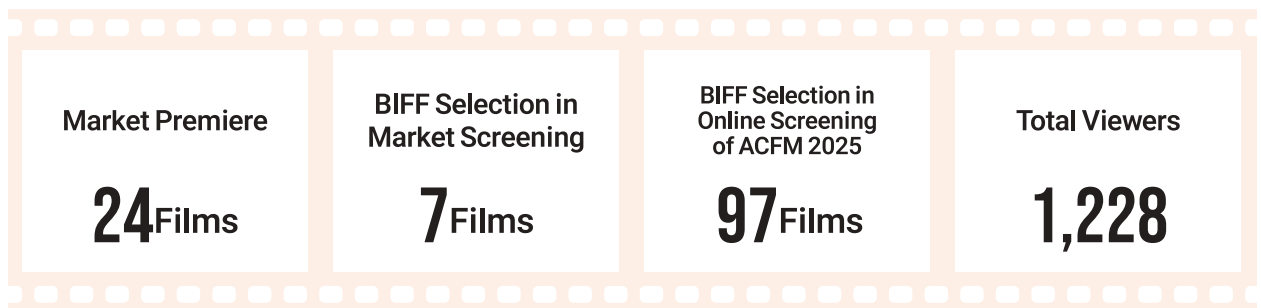

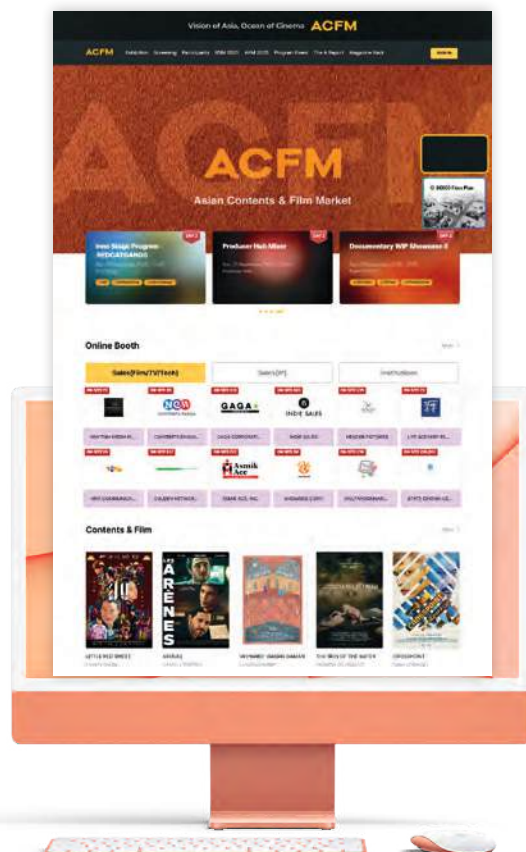

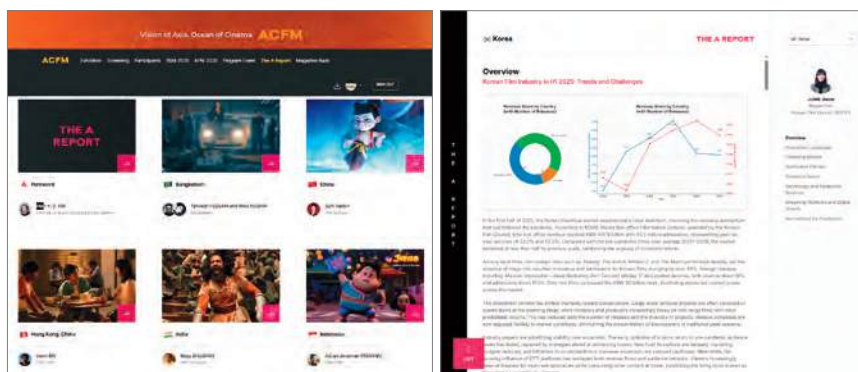
The A

The A is ACFM's flagship program, designed around its core values of Asia, Alliance, Analysis, Agent, and Art (including both artistry and technology). This program embodies ACFM's leadership and philosophy, serving as a key platform that connects creators and industry leaders in the Asian film and content industries.

The A Report

Published twice a year, this specialized report on the Asian film industry serves as a key indicator for understanding the Asian market by providing cross-comparative analyses of industry trends across 17 participating countries, including Taiwan, Japan, India, Malaysia, and the Philippines. Surpassing 1,221 online views, the report offers in-depth data and insights to industry professionals, strengthening its role as a knowledge hub for the Asian film industry.

The A Summit

This event served as a platform to examine key agendas in the Asian film and content industries through the latest data, while facilitating concrete collaborations among institutional and market leaders. It provided a comprehensive overview of regional industry trends, audience behaviors, distribution landscapes, and policy incentives. The event also led to the establishment of joint development strategies and cooperative agendas, agreements on cross-promotions and collaborative programs, as well as sharing of policy-related resources and the expansion of networks for co-production, investment, and distribution—marking a significant outcome.

Functioning as a practical platform that connects creators and industry leaders, the event exemplified a positive cycle of information sharing, policy linkage, and business collaboration. In the long term, it is expected to generate ripple effects such as the dissemination of standardized industry indicators, revitalized human and technological exchange between regions, broader audience engagement and market accessibility, and enhanced brand value for both the city and the event.

Asian Project Market

The Asian Project Market is a platform that identifies Asian new feature film projects in development and production, providing business opportunities for financing, co-production, distribution, and international sales. This year, 30 new projects from 15 countries were selected and introduced. Through the Asian Project Market Showcase, projects were pitched and three jury members were appointed for the APM Award to select the winners in three award categories. In total, 11 projects were awarded across 13 award categories.
